For information of Philadelphia, a review of Louisville indices was negative on all individuals listed in re airtel with the exception of the following:

GUY STRAIT was the subject of Louisville file 145-315, entitled "GUY STRAIT; ITOM; OO: SAN FRANCISCO (SF file 145-669)". According to this file, STRAIT, in 1973, was well known to West Coast law enforcement due to his involvement in producing and distributing pornographic movies photographs and literature, specializing in pornography involving male participants of all ages. A master list was obtained, by a source, which listed individuals throughout the United States who were receiving pornographic materials from STRAIT. A copy of this list was sent to the Louisville Division; and, it was requested local law enforcement authorities be advised of the individuals in the Kentucky area due to some of these individuals possibly being involved in local pornographic activities and/or related crimes. After providing this information to local authorities, no further investigation was conducted.

After careful consideration of your appeal, I have decided to affirm the initial action in this case. Certain information was properly withheld from you pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C), (7)(D) and (7)(E). These pertain to investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would, respectively, constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties, disclose the identities of confidential sources and disclose certain investigative techniques. Only the names of Bureau agents were excised on the basis of 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C). None of the material being withheld is appropriate for discretionary release.

You initially requested only records connecting you with Your appeal letter expanded that request to include your entire F.B.I. file. This new request will be processed chronologically by the Bureau as if received on May 26, 1978, which is the date it was actually received by this Office.

Any request for correction or amendment of information in F.B.I. records should be submitted to F.B.I. Headquarters and should be clearly marked "Privacy Correction Request." Your letter of request should indicate the particular records involved, the nature of the correction sought and the perceived justification for the correction or amendment.

Copies of reported publication were not available at the usual sources and vendors of underground newspapers in San Francisco so that the character or existence of this publication has not been verified.

Post Office Box 792 was rented in January, 1965, to GUY STRAIT who stated on his application that he was in the publishing business at 471 Minna Street, San Francisco, California, and resided at 22 Russ Street, San Francisco, California.

GUY STRATT is the subject of a current Interstate Transportation of Obscene Matter case (Bufile 145-4234) of which San Francisco is Office of Origin. STRAIT has been reported to be a publisher of homosexual material. When interviewed on July 26, 1968, STRAIT reported that he was publishing three magazines and three "hippie-type" newspapers with the following names:

> "Maverick Tribune" "Love Street" "Free Press"

It may be noted that there is a proliferation of "hippietype" newspapers with emphasis on nudity and sex which are sold on street corners by hippie types at premium prices. The captioned publication "Haight-Ashbury Maverick" is possibly one of this type.

UACB or upon receipt of information that it is being published as a "New Left" publication, no further investigation is being conducted by the San Francisco Office.

A review of the photographs submitted by Miami Office in this matter revealed the photos are not familiar to the San Francisco Division and may have been submitted by Los Angeles. According to investigation at Miami, GUY STRAIT hand-carried these photos to Miami. STRAIT is known to the San Francisco Division as dealing in male homosexual material, but investigation to date has not indicated that he is dealing in hard-core material.

GUY STRAIT, subject of this investigation, has previously been identified by the San Francisco Office as owner and operator of Strait Publications, 22 Russ Street, San Francisco, telephone number 431-4260. This concern publishes underground type newspapers, as well as various homosexual and sexually oriented publications.

By communication dated December 2, 1968, the Miami Office advised that on October 15, 1968, the Miami Book and Magazine Store was raided by officers of the Vice Squad of the Miami Police Department, and 13 packets of homosexual photographs and a large number of books, magazines, and non obscene motion picture film were seized without a search warrant, and without any prior judicial decision of obscenity.

On November 22, 1968, Judge GERALD TOBIN, Miami, Florida, ordered that all the material seized by the Miami Police Department on October 15, 1968, be returned to the owner of the bookstore with the exception of 13 packets of photographs, which Judge TOBIN ordered turned over to the FBI.

These investigations are maintained in two separate main files at FBI Headquarters. Also located were four additional documents indexed to your name but in the files of other individuals. references are referred to as "see" references. Your main files and "see", references consist of 168 pages, of which we are releasing 34 pages. The remaining pages were withheld in their entirety as their release would reveal our investigative interest in third parties, the names of FBI agents and confidential source identities and information. Title 5, United States Code, Section 552 (b) (7) (C) and (b) (7) (b). Notations citing the exemptions used to delete information from the pages being released to you have been made in the margins. Our indices make reference to a file on another subject, in which one Guy Strait was indexed seven times. file was destroyed in accordance with statutory provisions of Title 44, United States Code, Section 33. In view of this, we are unable to determine if the Guy Strait that was indexed in this file was identical with you. For your information, the disposition of

For your information, the disposition of records, including corrections and alterations, is not discretionary with Federal agencies, but is governed by regulations issued by the National Archives and Records Service, General Services Administration.

The search for information in response to your request was limited to those records in our central records system which are maintained at FBI Headquarters, Washington, D. C. 





.On or about 9/1/73 captioned individual was arrested by the Los Angeles, California, Police Department (TAPD) in connection with his pornography activities. Thereafter based upon information developed by the LAPD the San Francisco, ... California, Police Department (SFPD) obtained a search warrant building located at 491 A Gurrero Street, San Francisco, and at this location seized numerous hard core pornographic movies, books, photographs, and other evidence linking this pornographic material to GUY STRAIT's operation. The SFPD is currently conducting an extensive investigation regarding STPAIT's activities and attempting to identify several young juveniles who participated in STRAIT's pornography operation. During recent months STRAIT and some of his juvenila associates resided at as well. as traveled around the United States in a mobile home owned by STRAIT. Prior to moving to Hollywood, California, STRAIT reportedly resided at 24014 Sunnyglen, Huffman, Texas.

STRAIT was released on bail after arrest in Los Angeles at which time he contacted and associate of STRAIT. 


